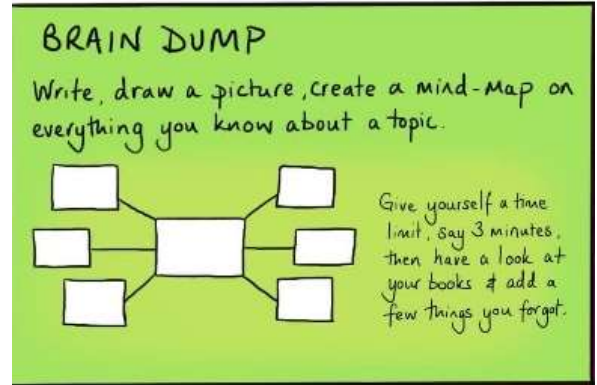


**Retrieval practice- Brain Dump**

1. Create a work space that is quiet and free from distractions. You will also need your knowledge organiser, workbook and pencil case on desks
2. Open Knowledge organiser to page 2 and choose a process knowledge retrieval to focus on (Brain Dump)
3. Choose a subject that you need to focus on. You can see this in the timetables that are on page 1 of your knowledge organisers. Each night students should complete 3 subjects- 20minutes per subject for an hour in total.

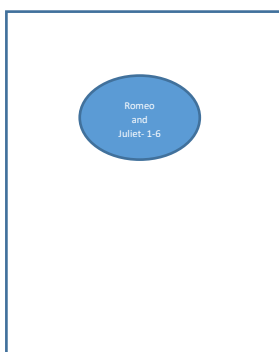

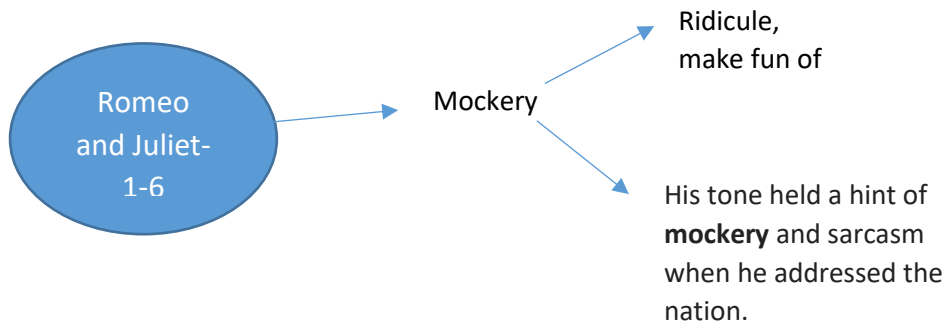
4. Choose a small section of the page to work on (and explicitly say “we are working on numbers 1-6, English Key vocabulary”)

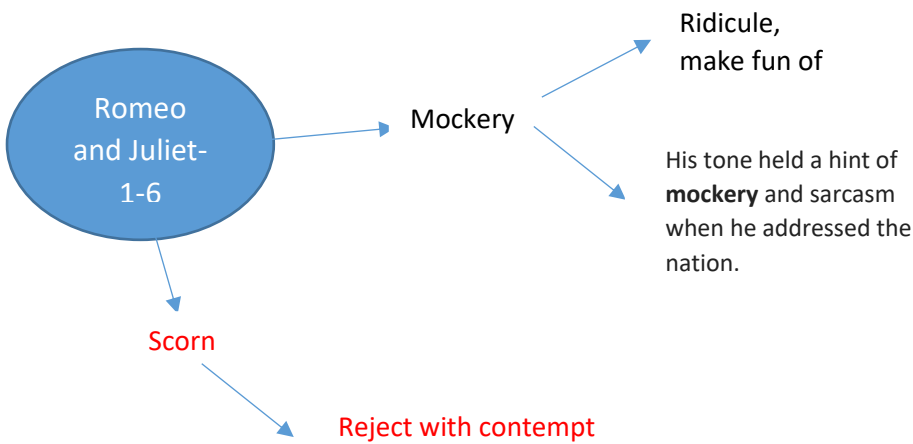
5. Using approximately half a page in the student work book, draw a small circle and put the topic inside the circle



6. Without looking, students have **2 minutes** to write down as many terms from that part of the KO as they can remember. CHALLENGE- From each word, students add the definition **AND** use then try to use the key vocabulary in a contextual sentence.



7. After the 2 minutes, students change colours and add any information they have missed.



8. After the 2 minutes, students attempt a different subject and repeat process. They should come back to their original after 5 minutes and attempt this again looking for improvements.

**EXAMPLES**
