Next week, we have Parents' Evenings and our Easter Service at St Swithun's Church. I look forward to seeing as many Trinity families as possible at both events.

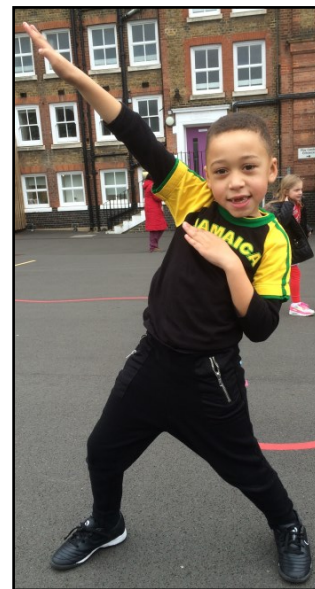
Can I remind everyone that we break up on Thursday next week and that this day will be a half day. Children should be picked up at 1:15pm.
