We are entering into the final few weeks of the first term of this calendar year. We have a number of amazing events planned for our pupils including Christmas jumper day, Christmas dinner day, and a host of Christmas services across all year groups but we are most looking forward to the end of term celebration assemblies across Years 7-11 in which we will celebrate the outstanding achievements of pupils throughout the course of this term.

We have recently updated our behaviour policy in order to ensure that all of our parents/carers are acutely aware of our high expectations surrounding our school's uniform, equipment and behaviour expectations both inside and outside of lessons. We want to continue to work in collaboration with our parents/carers and it may be useful for you to review the policy so you support your child in demonstrating the behaviours of an outstanding Trinitarian during their time at the school. Lastly, we also wanted to draw your attention to our new rewards system that has been put in place for pupils within our behaviour policy. We are committed to having a strong emphasis on excellent attendance, punctuality, behaviour, academic effort and wider school contributions. Pupils are rewarded for these contributions via our new "net golden ticket" system. The system is designed to reward pupils that are accumulating a significant amount of praise points/achievements for their achievements across the school. The system also takes into consideration the amount of negative behaviour points a pupil is getting, with this being a contributing factor of their overall behaviour record. We will be using the praise points totals/golden tickets awarded to offer a rewards trip at the end of the academic year. With limited spaces available it is important we prioritise rewarding pupils who have made outstanding contributions (including golden ticket accumulation) and those who have accumulated the fewest amount of sanctions throughout the course of the academic year.

We look forward to sending our pupils of into their Christmas holidays in a few week's time in good spirits. Thank you in advance for your continued support of the school.
