

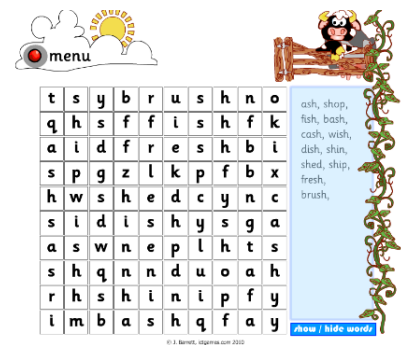

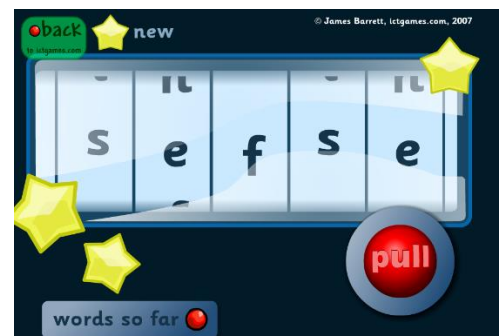
Useful websites to help with reading

DJ Cow- all the spelling patterns in a word search. Children could write down the words when they find them.



Blending Bingo- Select a sound (from Soundwrite word mat) and ask your child to write down 6 words with that sound. Keep pulling the trigger and get them to cross off the word when it comes up! Fun for the whole family too!



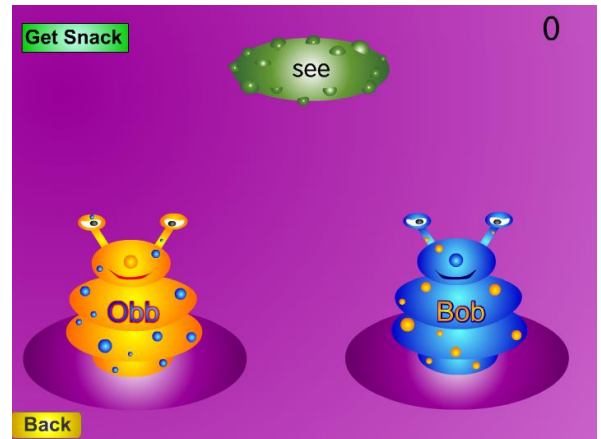
Loo, cover check

A very funny game in which the children have to select the correct letters to spell high frequency and tricky words. A great extension would be to then get the children to put the word into a sentence.

Obb and Bob- This game allows children to apply the different sounds and sort words into real and not real.

Consonant Diagraphs- a simple game that helps children build words using blends such as sh, sl, sk, where the second sound is harder to hear. A great extension would be to then ask the children to write this into a sentence.

SoundsWrite App- This app allows the children to make a profile and work their way through the sounds in the soundswrite programme.



Pirate Phonics App- This app uses the same sounds from the soundswrite programme and allows the children to collect gold coins as they move along!
